

LOW SPEED 2

Low Speed 2 is a reverse style 2008 57' Semi Traditional narrowboat. The hull was built by HT Fabrications and she was fitted out by Admiral Narrowboats. She is in lovely condition both inside & out.

The stern deck houses the Vetus 4 cylinder engine which has 1,225 hours recorded. The steps lead into the galley. A good size at 10' 6", this hosts an eye level gas oven and grill, a microwave, 4 burner gas hob and a 12v fridge with icebox. The is room in the cupboards under the hob for a washing machine but there is not one currently installed.

The 15' saloon follows. There are two L shaped dinettes in here, each of which makes into a double berth, and each has storage under. There is a side hatch on the starboard side opposite the first dinette.

The corridor on the starboard side leads to the bathroom. The door is a sliding one and behind it the is a tiled shower cubicle with glass door, a Thetford C200 cassette loo, a stainless steel counter sunk circular basin over a vanity unit, and good shelf space next to the shower.

Through another sliding door into the bedroom in the forward cabin. The fixed double measures 6' x 4' and has two large drawers under. There are two floor to ceiling wardrobes at the foot of the bed (one is a double wardrobe) and cupboards over the bedhead.

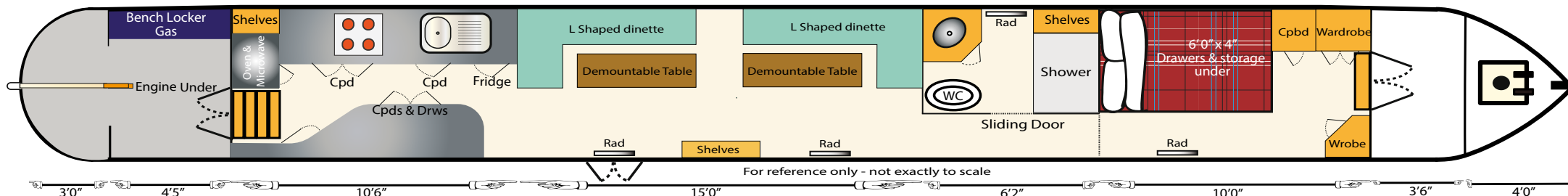
Out through the bow doors into the well deck, and the bow locker is all just storage as the gas is on the stern deck.

There are 4 radiators on board heated by a diesel fired Webasto system, lights throughout are LED, and on board 230v power is sourced via landline hook up or the 2.5kw inverter.

There are also two tilting 100w solar panels on board for battery charging.

She has been really well looked after and is ready to go!
